Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 9, 2024

We celebrated the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, last Sunday with our annual Corpus Christi procession to our various shrines for Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The weather was threatening, but a crowd of about 150 people, including the Knights of St. John and



Knights of Columbus, the Daughters of Isabella, and many parishioner families participated. Teresa Merkel led the Rosary and Tom Baumer and Gary Laker provided their golf carts for transportation. Lots of little girls were busy throwing flower petals along the way.



Several Eucharistic Ministers helped carry the Blessed Sacrament under a canopy carried by 4 energetic men. Matt Trossman and the Parish Choir provided and led the music at each shrine. Our firing squad was busy each place at the time of Benediction. Several Altar Servers ministered well. Our local police provided for our safety. Mary Gehring coordinated the whole event and all enjoyed a taco luncheon provided by our volunteers. Thanks to all who made this our successful 178th consecutive Corpus Christ Procession.



This week we are back to Ordinary Time. Our first reading is from the Book of Genesis. It tells the results of the first couple eating the forbidden fruit in the Garden. The man blames the woman who blames the serpent who tricked her. God curses the serpent and predicts enmity between the serpent and the woman. In the second reading St. Paul writes to the Corinthians proclaiming the importance of faith in God who raised Jesus from the dead. God's grace is bestowed in abundance on all who believe. Even though some believers are growing old and weak externally, their inner being is being made stronger and they can look forward to eternal joy in heaven.



Mark's Gospel tells of Jesus and the disciples returning home to a great crowd of people. Jesus' relatives tried to seize Him while the Scribes said

he is possessed by the devil Beelzebul. Jesus countered by questioning how Satan can drive out Satan? He said a house divided against itself cannot stand. No one can rob a strong person unless he is first tied up. Jesus proclaimed that all those who do God's will are His mother and relatives. **Do you find Jesus' Gospel behavior hard to believe and accept? Do you believe that you are a relative of Jesus? How does that make you feel?**
