The United States sets aside the third Sunday of June for Father's Day. Catholics can use this secular holiday as an opportunity not only to celebrate their dads, but also to thank God for the gift of fatherhood as a whole. It can remind us of God's commandment to honor our parents and to meditate on how our own fathers image God the Father for us.

God gives us fatherhood to remind us of His hand in our lives. Fatherhood has its origins in God, who chose to reveal Himself to us as Our Father, sending His only Son for the sake of our salvation. Fathers therefore have a special role in revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God. There exists no better image of God the Father than one's own dad. By their fallen human nature, no dad can live up to the image of God, but in their striving for virtue, they model for us how to seek God. Through them, God reminds us of His strength and stability, of how He protects us and provides for us, and how He delights in our flourishing. God gives us this gift through any father-figure in our lives. God has even provided the priesthood as spiritual fathers so that we never forget that He has an active hand in our lives.

As a Church community, we need to encourage and support men to follow the example of St. Joseph and embrace their various roles as father. Even if a man is not a parent, he is still called to spiritual fatherhood—a fatherhood that fosters others' relationship with God, protecting them from evil and providing an example of Christ's love. St. Joseph, himself, was unexpectedly called to both practical and spiritual fatherhood, and amid very difficult circumstances. But despite all obstacles, Joseph was faithful. He welcomed life, offering care and protection to Mary and Jesus. We pray that each expectant father will find courage in the example of St. Joseph and offer loving, life-affirming support to the mother of his child.

May St. Joseph watch over all fathers today and ask for the grace they need to lead their families to Heaven. St. Joseph, pray for us!

## BATESVILLE PREGNANCY HOTLINE

When the abortion pill, mifepristone, was approved by the FDA during the Clinton administration, restrictions were put in place due to known side effects such as internal hemorrhaging, infections, sepsis, and other life-threatening conditions for the mother. The drug had to be prescribed by a physician. The physician had to see the patient before prescribing it, dispense it in person, and conduct a follow up assessment. In addition, the FDA put a "black box" warning on the drug's label to alert women to the serious risks. The next two administrations removed these restrictions. Today mifepristone can be ordered online from anywhere in the world and mailed anywhere in the U.S. The largest study of mifepristone ever conducted found that in nearly 11% of cases, women who take the drug experience a "serious adverse health event", such as sepsis or hemorrhaging. That is more than 1 in 10 women. 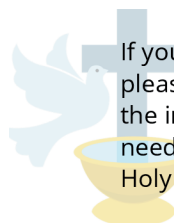
