Through an utterly free decision, God has revealed Himself and given Himself to man. This He does by revealing the mystery, His plan of loving goodness, formed from all eternity in Christ, for the benefit of all people. God has fully revealed this plan by sending His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.

God, who dwells in unapproachable light, wants to communicate His own divine life to those He

freely created, in order to adopt them as sons and daughters in His Only-Begotten Son. By revealing Himself God wishes to make them capable of responding to Him, and of knowing Him, and of loving Him far beyond their own natural capacity.

By His Revelation (Scripture and Tradition), the invisible God, from the fullness of His love, addresses us as His friends, and moves among us, in order to invite and receive us into His own company. The adequate response to this invitation is faith, which is first of all a personal adherence to God. At the same time, and inseparably, it is a free assent to the whole truth that God has revealed. As personal adherence to God and assent to His truth, Christian faith differs from our faith in any human person. It is right and just to entrust oneself wholly to God and to believe absolutely what He says.

This faith in God is possible only by grace and the interior helps of the Holy Spirit. But it is no less true that believing is an authentically human act. Trusting in God and cleaving to the truths He has revealed are contrary neither to human freedom nor to human reason. In faith, the human intellect and will cooperate with divine grace. To live, grow, and persevere in faith until the end we must nourish it with the word of God; we must pray that the Lord will increase our faith; it must be working through charity, abounding in hope, and rooted in the faith of the Church.

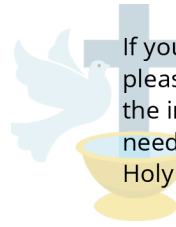
