"Ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers..." (Luke 10:2)
This week Jesus sends seventy-two of his followers to share the gospel he himself had been proclaiming to them. This is more than just the Apostles, whom He has sent out earlier (Luke 9:1-6).

These Apostles would be the first bishops and priests. But to share the gospel was not meant to be the task of the clergy alone, not then and not now. Before sending out what today we might call lay people, Jesus instructed them to pray to God the Father to send more laborers for the harvest. Then He sent *them* out to harvest souls.

So it is today. Jesus tells all of us to pray for harvesters and, in doing that, to recognize that we are praying not just for others but for ourselves, that each of us will hear the Lord's call and respond, whether clergy, religious sisters or brothers, or lay people. Whether young or old, male or female, a cradle Catholic or a recent convert. We are all called to share the treasure of the Faith. In his encyclical *The Light of Faith*, Pope Benedict XVI wrote, "Those who have opened their hearts to God's love, heard his voice and received his light, cannot keep this gift to themselves. ... The word, once accepted, becomes a response, a confession of faith, which spreads to others and invites them to believe."

The seventy-two Jesus sent out wanted to share with others the gift they had received. It's because of their response that we're here today. They preached and others heard and responded, and these in turn did the same, all the way across the centuries to those who have shared the gospel with us, in our homes, in our parishes, in our schools and workplaces, on television and radio, through books and now social media. "It is through an unbroken chain of witnesses that we come to see the face of Jesus." That chain goes all the way back to the scene in today's Gospel! We are part of that beautiful chain, and Jesus wants us to be links that will keep that chain going. Pray for laborers for the harvest and ask the Lord to show you how you can work in His fields alongside everyone else.

Please Welcome Missionaries from Uganda

Sherry Meyer, a lay missionary serving on behalf of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, has been living in Uganda, East Africa for more than 30 years. In Uganda, she has worked with Comboni Missionary priest Fr. Tonino Pasolini. Together they established a pastoral, catechetical and liturgical training center for the diocese, provided leadership in several parishes and started Radio Pacis, which broadcasts in local languages and English. Sherry and Fr. Tonino will speak at the Masses next weekend. A second collection will be taken up to support their parish and their radio ministry. What is an "Oblation"?

At most Masses, during the prayer at the altar, you have probably heard the priest use the unfamiliar term "oblation," as in "Look, we pray, upon the oblation of your Church..." What exactly is an "oblation"? An oblation is an act of offering something, like praise or thanksgiving, to God. In the Mass, it means especially the offering of Christ's Body and Blood in the Sacrifice of the Mass. So that's what oblation means. Now you know!

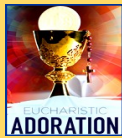
