### Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

### Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 7, 2024

I am writing these reflections almost 2 weeks in advance because I planned to be in the middle of my vacation on the weekend of July 6. Since I contracted Covid-19 on June 25, I have to change my plans. Instead of spending several days with my sister



Mary and her husband Weber at their home in Missoula, Montana, I will be flying to San Jose, CA, to visit with my other sister Rita and her daughters Meagen and Hayley who live in Half Moon Bay, California. I hope you all had a safe and enjoyable Fourth of July celebration while I was gone! I'll be back July 13.

Our Scriptures this weekend speak to us of God's presence and action in and for



His people. The prophet Ezekiel is sent by God to the Israelites who have turned away from God and been unfaithful to the Covenant. Ezekiel preaches to the people & challenges them to return to their loving God. St. Paul writes to the Corinthians describing his struggles with temptations. He begs God to take them away and God assures him that His grace is sufficient. St. Paul then rejoices in his weaknesses, because "when he is

weak, then he is strong" in God's loving grace.

St. Mark describes Jesus' return to Nazareth, His home town. Jesus astonishes the people when He preaches in their synagogue. They wonder where He got all this

wisdom as the Son of the carpenter Joseph and his wife Mary. The people took offense at Him because He was not following their cultural expectations; Jesus should be a carpenter, not a preacher and healer. Jesus responds by pointing out that prophets are often not accepted by their own people. He was



not able to help many people because of their lack of faith. How do you react to Jesus' experience with His own people? Do you permit people to grow and change in response to their personal situations and God's call? Have you become a different person as you grow and mature, or are you stuck in a rut and unable to change even when you know you need to change and develop your gifts?




