# Holy Family Parish

*"You shall love the Lord, your God...and your neighbor as yourself" (Luke 10:27).*



We've heard it a thousand times: love your neighbor as yourself. The scribe knows this too; he knows that he is supposed to love his "neighbor." But who, exactly, is his neighbor, he wants to know. In other words, who is he *required* to love, to pray for, to do good for when possible? What are the allowed limits, the boundaries, the parameters of his love? Who does he NOT have to love? Who can he get away with not loving? Who is he allowed

to be indifferent to, to not care about, to disregard or even regard with contempt?

No one. Absolutely no one. Not one single soul is excluded from his love. That's what Jesus tells him. Samaritans and Jews hated each other. They *hated* each other. To a Jew, there was no one worse than a Samaritan, and to a Samaritan, no one worse than a Jew. The Romans were better, even if only a little. Yet here is Jesus, holding up a Samaritan as an example of the kind of love we all called to, a care, a concern that does not ask who you are, what color you are, what language you speak, where you come from, why you are here. A love that only wants to know one thing: what do you need? How can I help? That's Christian love, because Christian love is an expression of God's own love. What does God see when He looks at us, when He looks at anyone? He sees our sinful, broken, messed up selves, and he sees His beloved son or daughter. Jesus looks at us and asks one question: how can I help this poor child of God, my sister, my brother?

The world tells us that it's OK to leave some people out of our circle of care. It tells us that we are surrounded by "enemies" who don't think like us, who don't live like us, who don't worship like us, and that's just the way it is. Jesus rejects this. He holds up for us a higher standard, God's own standard. Let's take up the challenge. Let's ask the Holy Spirit to show us who our Samaritans are. To whom is our heart closed? Who do we refuse to care about? Whose wounds mean nothing to us, whose suffering leaves us unmoved? Let's pray to our merciful God – Who has shown us *countless* mercies despite our infidelities – to open our hearts, to make them as wide as possible. And then ask Him: who can I help? How can I help?

Whose politics don't you like? Pray for them. Talk to them. What bishops and priests drive you crazy. Leave it all in the Lord's hands and pray for them! And stop talking about them. Whom do you judge, condemn in your heart? Give them some room in that heart and give thanks to God for them. Let the Sacred Heart of Jesus be the measure of your love. Go for it. Amen? Amen!

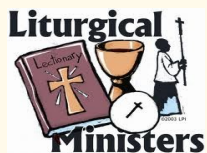

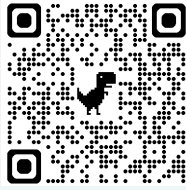

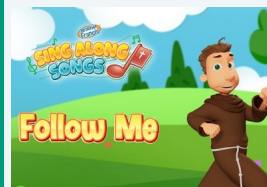
