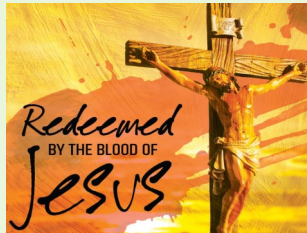
Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 14, 2024

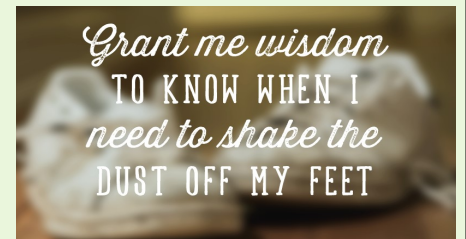
Since I came down with Covid back on June 26 and had to delay my vacation trip, I am writing these reflections about 2 weeks early while I still have time. Now my plan is to leave for vacation on July 6 and return on July 12. My family will meet in Half Moon Bay, CA, where my youngest sister & her daughters live. We will be together for most of the week and plan to visit several of the parks and beaches and historical sites in the area, as well as eating together and sharing our lives and bringing each other up to date.



Our Scriptures for this weekend continue to describe the ministry of prophets, apostles, and disciples of Jesus. The Prophet Amos tells of his difficulties with the high priest who sends him away and refuses to let Amos preach. Amos replies by claiming that he didn't want to be a prophet, but the Lord took him from his flocks and told him to prophesy to the people of Israel. St. Paul, writing to the Ephesians, celebrates God's sending Jesus into the world to enable us to be His adopted children. We have redemption through Jesus' death and resurrection, receiving His lavish grace. We were chosen and destined to exist for God's glory. We have been sealed with the Holy Spirit.



In our Gospel from St. Mark, we learn about Jesus sending out the apostles two by two to continue His work of preaching and healing. Jesus tells them to take nothing for the journey: no food, sack, or money, only a walking stick. They are to trust in the hospitality of the people where they are preaching. If they are not welcomed, they should shake the dust from their feet, a sign of their disgust. They went and preached repentance and drove out demons and anointed and healed the sick.



Are you persistent in living the Good News and inviting others to believe? How do you deal with rejection or disinterest? Are you able to live without a lot of extra stuff, or do you have to have the latest of everything? Jesus calls us to live simply and use our excess for the poor!



We offer our condolences and promise of prayers for Albert Meyer whose funeral Mass was at Holy Family on July 3. May he rest in peace and may his family be consoled.

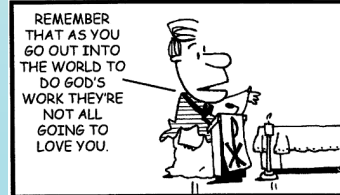
