## Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 28, 2024

Congratulations to all who worked hard setting up and preparing for the Freudenfest celebration. From my perspective all seemed to go well and it appeared to me that people were having a good time. The long lines for food and drink were the only drawback for me, but with such big crowds that was inevitable. I haven't spoken with the members of the committee yet, so I'm interested in their perspective. God certainly blessed us with good weather, not too hot and no rain!



This weekend we are having our Rummage Sale and expect big crowds for this event. Again, thanks to the committee and all who worked so hard preparing & setting up for this annual event. I appreciate the commitment of all involved, as well as the customers who come to support our Rummage Sale. It is a blessing for all our people and the people of the area as they prepare for the opening of school.



Our Scriptures for this weekend emphasize God's care for the hungry. The first reading from the Book of Kings tells of the prophet Elisha reassuring the people that God can feed 100 people with 20 barley loaves. There was even some left over after all had eaten their fill. Again we hear from St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians as he urges all the new believers to live good lives. Paul emphasizes the importance of love, unity, and peace. They are called to hope in the one Lord with one faith, one baptism, one God and Father who is over all and in all.



Our Gospel from St. John tells of Jesus preaching to a large crowd across the Sea of Galilee. Passover was near and Jesus challenged Philip by asking where they could get food enough for this crowd of people. Philip said 200 days' wages could not buy enough food for everyone to get a little. Andrew pointed out that a boy had 5 barley loaves and 2 fish, but what good was that? The 5000 people reclined on the grass and Jesus blessed the loaves and fish and gave them to the crowd. All had more than enough to eat and the leftovers filled 12 baskets!



The people wanted to carry Jesus off and make Him king, so He withdrew to the mountain alone. **How do you respond to the miracle of the loaves and the fishes? Do you believe that Jesus has the power to meet people's needs today? Why are so many people starving all over the world? What can you do about it?**
