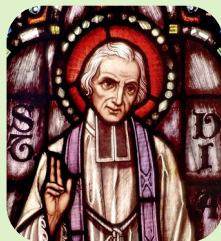
### Congratulations, Oliver Glen Zapfe!

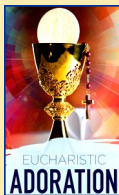

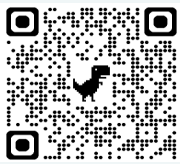

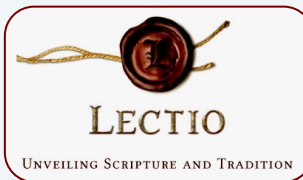
