Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

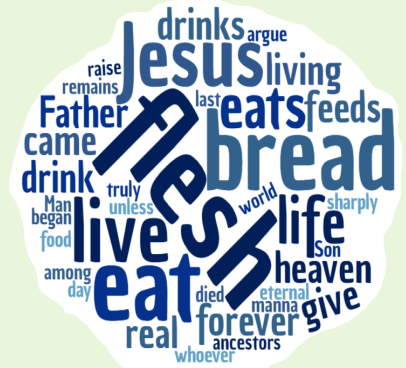
Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time August 11, 2024

We now begin the new school year with its challenges and rewards for all who participate in any level of schooling, especially students and teachers. Parents also have an important part to play in providing a quiet and supportive place for homework, as well as appropriate coaching and help for their students. I remember spending hours doing my homework, even when I wanted to be outside playing early in the school year.



This weekend's Scriptures continue Jesus' "Bread of Life" discourse, after we hear from Elijah in our first reading. Elijah is trying to escape from Queen Jezebel who is trying to put him to death. An exhausted Elijah prayed for the Lord to take his life, but instead God gave him a cake and jug of water for his nourishment. Then Elijah was able to walk for 40 days to God's mountain, Horeb. In our second reading, St. Paul again encourages the Ephesians to live good lives, avoiding all bitterness, anger, and malice. They are to be compassionate and forgiving and so be imitators of God and live in love as Christ did, who handed Himself over in sacrifice for us on the cross.

In John's Gospel the people reacted to Jesus calling Himself the "Bread come down from heaven." They recognized Him as Joseph and Mary's son and question His saying He came down from heaven. Jesus responds by saying His Father sent Him and He will raise them on the last day. But they must listen to His Father and come to Jesus. Whoever believes what Jesus teaches has eternal life. This is because Jesus is the Bread of Life. As they know, their ancestors ate manna in the desert and died, but Jesus says that whoever eats this Bread will live forever. The Bread that Jesus will give is His flesh for the life of the world.



Do you believe that Jesus gives us His flesh for our nourishment? How do you prepare to receive the Bread of Life at Mass?



Does this special divine nourishment affect your daily life from one week to the next? What changes do you need to make in response to Jesus' love and care?

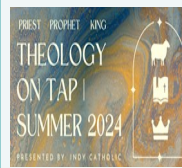
FORMED® PICK OF THE WEEK

Sent Evangelization - "Whom shall we send?"

In the words of St. Paul, "Everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved, but how can men believe in him in whom they have never heard and how can they hear without a preacher & how can men preach unless they are Sent." (Rm. 10:13-15). But who will be sent? Sent not to distant missions, but within our own parish territories, to the vast & largely forgotten majority of our brothers and sisters who do not yet know Jesus yet live surrounding our churches. The Answer: Simple. But not easy. Sent Evangelization provides Catholic pastors with the method and tools to reach all the souls living within their parish boundaries (Christus Dominus no. 30.1) & does so by equipping parishioners with a neighborhood evangelization method, based on baptismal identity and focused on charity.

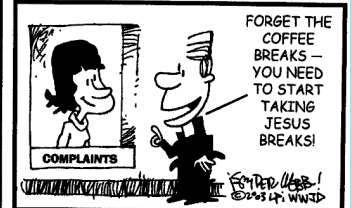

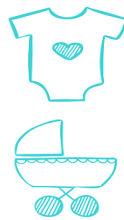
