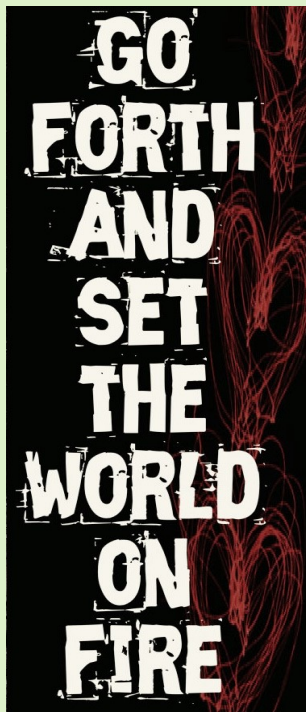

"I have come to set the earth on fire..."

(Luke 12:49)

We hate to hear these days of the common wildfires that blaze out of control in the west or up in Canada. The loss of homes, communities, and even lives is terrible, and we are grateful to those who work so hard to prevent and manage forest fires.

From an ecological standpoint, though, fires can be beneficial. Scientists say that they have always been a part of the life cycle of forests, rejuvenating them by burning up old growth so that new life can emerge. I once went hiking in an ancient forest that had burned down almost completely several times over the millennia, and each time it rebound with even more forms of plant life. This is the kind of destruction that leads to new growth and flourishing life.

Jesus says that He has come to set the earth on fire. The fire He brings is the Holy Spirit, sent into the world to burn up all that is opposed to life so that new life can emerge. Jesus came so that God's creation could be renewed, restored, and rejuvenated. Saint Paul tells us that in the end all creation will be set free and share in the glorious freedom of the children of God (Romans 8:21). This is why Jesus wants the whole world to be set ablaze, every heart on fire with the power of the Spirit to bring forth a new creation, victorious over sin, evil, and death. This is why. Jesus lived and died and rose again. This is what we celebrate every time we come to Mass.

Lord Jesus, stoke the fire of Your Spirit in our hearts. May that fire burn away whatever leads us away from You and set us ablaze with love of God and our neighbor. Plant within our hearts new growth of joy, peace, mercy, faithfulness, and goodness. Make us sparks of Your divine life in our parish and in the world, so that all the earth may be set on fire with your love and rise to newness of life. Amen!

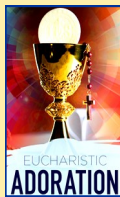
