


Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time August 18, 2024

Thanks to all who celebrated with me and Fr. Joe at our Farewell celebration this past Sunday. We were very pleased with the number of parishioners and friends who joined us for the Mass and luncheon. Thanks to all for your good wishes, cards, gifts and kind words. Thanks, too, to our parish staff and volunteers who planned the celebration and set up and decorated the cafeteria for this special occasion. The food was delicious, the decorations beautiful, the service outstanding, and the unanimous support of all was appreciated. This was one of the best celebrations I have experienced in a long time! Fr. Joe will be moving soon, and I will be moving to St. Clement Friary on August 30.



On this 20th Sunday weekend, our Scriptures continue to speak to us about God's love and goodness, and especially Jesus as the Bread of Life come down from heaven. We are encouraged to embrace Wisdom in our first reading. The image used is that of a banquet; by eating and drinking wisdom, may we grow in our understanding of God. St. Paul writes to the Ephesians, reminding them to live wisely and use the opportunities given them to understand the will of God. They are to be filled with the Holy Spirit as they pray and sing together, giving thanks for everything in the name of Jesus.

The Gospel of St. John goes deeper into Jesus' Bread of Life discourse. The crowd wonders how Jesus can give them His flesh to eat. Jesus says that "unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you." His Flesh is true food and his Blood is true drink, and whoever eats and drinks will be raised on the last day. The Father sent Jesus into our world, and the one who feeds on Him will have life because of Him and will live eternally in heaven. **So again we are challenged to believe in Jesus and receive His Body and Blood in Holy Communion. How do you respond to this greatest gift of Jesus for you and all believers? Does receiving Communion bring you closer to your brothers and sisters, family and friends and neighbors, here and all over the world?**
