

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Twenty First Sunday in Ordinary Time, August 27, 2023

This week our Scriptures speak to us about the importance of legitimate and loyal authorities who serve the Lord. The reading from Isaiah describes a time in the Israelites' history when a disloyal leader had to be replaced by Eliakim who was chosen by the Lord to lead God's people. God promised to be with Eliakim and support him in his role as the master of the palace and a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Again we hear from St. Paul in the second reading as he writes to the Romans. Paul is praising God for His wisdom and knowledge and right judgments. God is above all people



and all things; to Him be glory forever. No one can match God's care and love for His people and all creation.

In St. Matthew's Gospel, we have the account of Jesus asking His disciples who they think He is. After several incorrect answers, Jesus asks them again. Good old St. Peter responds with the correct answer: "Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus praises Peter for his answer, and says that it comes from God Himself.



Jesus goes on to reveal that Peter is to be the rock, the firm foundation, upon which Jesus' Church is to be built. Furthermore, the Church will be immune from attacks by the evil one. Peter will have the keys to God's Kingdom, with the power to bind and loose; in other words, to be a strong and effective leader, able to make good and right judgments. How do we

answer Jesus' question about who we think He is? Do we see Jesus as God's Son, both human and divine? Do we choose to follow Him in all His teachings & example, loving and caring for the least and lowly, as well as the bad and the good? What does it mean for us to be members of God's family here on earth?

As we approach the new school year, I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all our Religious Education Teachers, Subs, Hall Monitors, Adult Faith Formators and other support personnel. They faithfully serve our students and adult members of our

parish and those interested in learning more about the Catholic faith. I'm grateful for the many other volunteers who give of their time and talent in our parish: Rummage Sale workers, Parish Council Members, Choir Members, Musicians, Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors. Greeters. Sacristans. Parish Festival workers. Car-



ing Committee members, Bereavement Luncheon servers, Turtle Soup makers, Altar Servers, Money Counters, Altar Linen Cleaners, and any other volunteers that I may have missed. You all work together to make this parish a place of generous service and loving compassion. May God bless you all and fill you with His love and grace!
