

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections


Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, September 3, 2023

I hope we all have survived the ups and downs of late August heat and lack of rain. This week is the beginning of September, with hopefully its cooler days and nights. We celebrate Labor Day on Monday, marking the end of summer! School is in session and our Autumn events have begun.

Our Scriptures this weekend challenge us to respond positively to God's calls and challenges. The Prophet Jeremiah reflects on his call from God to be a prophet, and the difficulties that call has brought him. People mock him, refuse to listen to him, and reproach him. Jeremiah wants to cease being a prophet of God, but his urge to prophesy is too strong, like a fire burning in his heart. In the second reading, St. Paul writes to the Romans, urging them to respond positively to God's call and challenge. They are



not to be conformed to the present evil age, but to carry out the will of God as it is revealed to them.



In St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tries to explain to the disciples what will happen to Him in Jerusalem, including his conflict with the scribes and chief priests. He says He will even be put to death and then be raised from the dead. Peter doesn't want to hear about Jesus' coming suffering and death, and denies that it will happen. Jesus says Peter is think-

ing not as God does, but as humans do, and calls Peter "Satan." Jesus goes on to further explain that His followers must take up their crosses and come after Him. Those who are willing to lose their lives for His sake will find eternal life. Gaining the whole world but forfeiting one's eternal life is useless. All will be blessed according to their conduct.

I forgot a few people in last week's litany of thanksgiving. Today I would like to thank our Finance Commission members for their important work; also the generous gardeners who take care of our flowers and bushes; those who help clean the snow

and ice from our sidewalks and parking lot; those who take care of the candles and votive lights in church, our aluminum can crusher, our video streamers, and our Rosary leaders. We friars want to thank our volunteer cooks who keep us well-fed. Finally, thanks to all the regular adorers who come each day to spend time with the Lord Jesus in the monstrance.






