HOLY FAMILY PARISH



“...no longer as a slave, but more than a slave, a brother.” (Philemon 16)

Today we hear an excerpt from Saint Paul's Letter to Philemon (fy-LEE-mun). Although this short letter was written under very different circumstances from ours, it has something important to teach us about what it means to be a Christian.

Paul is writing to Philemon about a man named Onesimus (oh-NEE-si-mus), who is a slave of Philemon. In Paul's time,

the acceptability of slavery was unquestioned in the Roman Empire (and all over the world, really). Apparently, Onesimus ran away from his master and was converted to Christ by Paul, who is now sending Onesimus back to Philemon with this letter. In it, Paul asks Philemon to welcome back Onesimus not as his slave, but as his *brother*. We are accustomed to hearing ourselves addressed as “brothers and sisters” at Mass, but we may not realize that this not just a friendly way of talking to each other. This language has been used by the Church from the very beginning to refer to fellow Christians, in recognition that they are all members of God's family in Christ, and so truly brothers and sisters to each other. This sort of thinking was completely foreign to the broader social mentality of Paul's time.

Paul wants Philemon to understand that the gospel subverts the usual social categories that divide people by class, economic status, nationality, sex, color, and so on. Philemon needs to realize that now that Onesimus is a Christian, Philemon can no longer think of him as a slave, but as his actual brother. As Paul says elsewhere, “there is neither slave nor free person... for you are all one in Christ Jesus” (Galatians 3:28).

Although, thankfully, slavery is no longer an accepted social institution in our country, many of the social divisions Paul knew remain with us. We also have strong tendencies to divide people into better or worse, worthy or unworthy, higher or lower. Paul reminds us that, no matter who they are, what language they speak, how much money or power they have, or where they come from, fellow Christians are truly our brothers and sisters. It is true that it can be hard to determine how best to express that fundamental truth in our own society, which is so diverse and divided. One thing we cannot do, however, as disciples of Jesus, is ignore the fact that we Christians are all members of one Family, and we ought to treat each other as brothers and sisters.

New Mass Being Offered on Wednesday Mornings

Beginning September 17, we will be offering a 6:00am Mass on Wednesday mornings here at Holy Family Church. (NOTE: This does *not* replace the 8:00am Mass – it is an *additional* Mass. There will be two Masses on Wednesday mornings.) This is in response to requests from those whose work schedules do not allow them to attend 8:00 Mass. We are trying this out to see if it will work, so we hope that many people who have to get to work early will take this opportunity to come to Mass during the week!

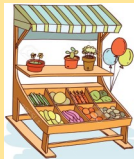
