## Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

### Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time, September 17, 2023

I'm writing this reflection several days in advance, since I will be out of town for the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Holy Rosary Parish in Houma, Louisiana, on Saturday, September 9th. I served at Holy Rosary Church from 1986 to 1996 and have been invited for their Jubilee celebration, along with the Bishop and many other priests.



Our Scriptures this weekend focus on the importance of forgiveness for sins, both those of our neighbors and families, as well as for ourselves by our loving God. Our first reading from the Book of Sirach reminds us that if we want to be forgiven by God for our sins, then we need to be willing and able to forgive our neighbors for their sins and injustices. We can't expect the Lord to forgive us, if we are not willing to forgive those who have hurt us. Nourishing anger and cherishing vengeance are not productive for anyone! St. Paul, writing to the Romans, tells them and us Christians that we are to live and die for the Lord because we are the Lord's people.



Christ is the Lord of both the dead and the living, even including ourselves.

St. Matthew's Gospel continues the same theme of forgiveness, as Peter asks Jesus how many times he must forgive his brother. Peter thinks that seven times is pretty generous, but Jesus counters that we must forgive seventy-seven times. Then Jesus tells a parable about a king who forgave his servant a huge debt, since he had no way of paying back what he owed. However, that servant went out and refused to have compassion and forgive a fellow servant who owed him just a small debt. Instead, he had him put in prison until he paid back the debt in full. The other servants went and told the master what had happened, and the master became angry and had the servant punished severely. So we should not expect God to forgive us, unless we are willing to forgive others, even 77 times! How are we going to put this lesson into practice this week, even 77 times? Do we have such needs in our town of Oldenburg, in our parish of Holy Family? May God give us the grace!

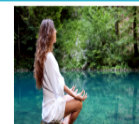

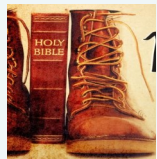

Tom Ricke and Linda Weigel from St. Mary Parish in Greensburg went on a Food For The Poor mission trip to Honduras in May. The purpose of the trip was to learn how FFTP helps the Honduran people. We were able to see firsthand the poverty of the area which is second only to Haiti in the western hemisphere. FFTP not only provides houses for folks but gives them education so they can sustain themselves by learning a trade such as fishing, sewing, or welding, etc. They assess the needs of the

people in the villages and build the infrastructure (electricity, clean water, proper sewage) and then build a community center. After that, the concrete houses are built to sustain the hurricane winds and rain. St. Mary has adopted a village in Cucuyagua. The people are living on mountainsides without safe water and toilets. The mayor and city council has donated prime land on a mountain plateau for their new village which will house 52 families. Please join us in our efforts to bring them out of poverty into a new life.
