Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 8, 2023

day and lots of interested and friendly people. I want to thank in a special way all who contributed to the success of our festival. Many worked hard during the previous week to prepare for the festival, setting up booths and displays, making the delicious mock-turtle soup, preparing the roast beef. Others braved the heat of the garage frying the hundreds of chickens on Sunday. Thanks to the bakers, pie makers, cafeteria workers, booth chairs and workers.

In our first Scripture reading this weekend, Isaiah compares the people of Israel and Jerusalem to an abandoned vineyard that once had the choicest vines but they failed to



care for them and produced only wild grapes. God expected loyalty & justice from the people, but they failed to live up to the covenant they had made. St. Paul encourages the Philippians to be people of prayer. He also calls them to believe and live what he has taught them and thus God will be with them. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tells another parable about a vineyard that was planted and leased to tenants. When the owner's servants came to get the crop of grapes, they were beaten and others were killed. When the owner sent his son, he also was killed because he was the

heir. What will the owner do? (Jesus is speaking to the chief priests & elders of the people.) They say that the tenants should be put to death. Jesus declares that the Kingdom will be taken away from those religious leaders and given to people who will believe and live their faith. Are we faithful believers, or people who are selfish and think only of ourselves? What should we do differently?


