Our Catholic faith holds marriage in very high regard. We believe that the matrimonial bond between Christians is not a purely human institution but has been "raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church* #1601). This means that

it is God who creates a marriage. And He does so for very good reasons.

First of all the grace of the sacrament of marriage is intended to perfect the love between the spouses and to strengthen their relationship. This grace helps them attain holiness and become who God created them to be. The grace of marriage also helps parents love the children God gives them and raise them as healthy and holy members of the Church and of the human family. Marriage is a school of love, with its ups and downs, its joys and struggles. And love is what it's all about.

The marriage covenant formed in the sacrament of matrimony, and strengthened over time by God's grace, is also intended by God to be an image of His absolute and unfailing love for His children. It is not for nothing that Scripture refers to the consummation of the New Covenant in Christ as "the wedding-feast of the Lamb" (Revelation 19:7).

This is why the Church is so protective of the marriage bond and does not treat it lightly. But we know that sometimes a marriage for any number of reasons does not survive its struggles. This is a cause for sadness, but it is also an invitation for us to offer our support to those who must deal with the aftermath of separation and divorce. They remain our brothers and sisters, and they need our help.

Marriage and family are so important! This week please take some time to pray for couples preparing for marriage. Pray for newly married couples. And pray for all families, but especially those who are going through hard times.

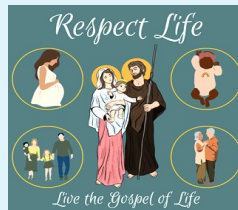

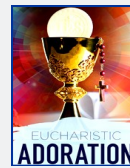
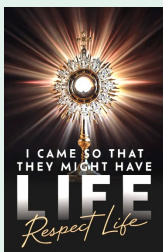
A PRAYER FOR LIFE to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament

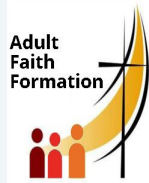
