
## **Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections**

### **Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 22, 2023**

We'd like to thank our four Parish Council members who have completed their 3-year terms of office and will be replaced by new Council members later this month. They are Doug Haskamp, Eric Heppner, Tom Honnert, and Diane Raver. Eric served as our Chair, and Diane served as our Secretary during this year, since November 2022. Our new Candidates for the Parish Council are Marcia Bischoff, Carla Enzinger, Mike Gehring, Joe Giesting, Wendy Havens, Steve Kerker, Kenny Meyer, and Marcie Trossman. Their candidate statements are available in the bulletin this weekend, and the elections will take place next weekend. The four who are chosen will begin their 3-year terms in November with installation at the November 14 Parish Council Meeting.




Our Scriptures this weekend deal with the civil government leaders and their place



in God's plans. Isaiah describes Cyrus, the King of Persia, as God's instrument in helping the Israelites rebuild their country by overcoming their other enemies. Isaiah says this is being done even though Cyrus does not recognize that his power comes from God. The people are to know that there is no other God in control: "I am the Lord, there is no other." St. Paul and his team of Silvanus and Timothy write to the Thessalonians, offering them grace and peace. In this introduction to their letter, they give thanks and pray for the Thessalonians, pointing out that the Gospel came to them, not only in word, but also in the power of the Holy Spirit and with conviction.

In Matthew's Gospel, the Pharisees are trying to trap Jesus. They try to butter Him up with false praises, emphasizing His truthful teachings. Then they ask Him the tricky question, "Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?" Jesus calls them hypocrites and asks to see the coin for the census tax. Jesus points out that it is Caesar's image on the coin, and says they should pay to Caesar what belongs to him, and give to God what belongs to God! Jesus does not get caught in their trap. He demonstrates that they are hypocrites by even having the Roman coin in their possession! Jesus doesn't allow Himself to be drawn into the controversial issue of whether they can be loyal Israelites and still follow the demands of their occupiers. How do we deal with the complicated issues of our times? Which are more important, God's teachings or political leadership? Which do we choose to follow?

**DID YOU KNOW...** At 6 weeks a preborn baby is NOT just a clump of cells. According to Dr. Tara

Sander Lee, senior fellow and director of life sciences at the nonprofit Charlotte Lozier Institute, "A preborn baby's heart is actively beating at 6 weeks and will have already beat nearly 16 million times by 15 weeks. In fact, at 6 weeks' gestation, the baby's heart rate is about 110 beats per minute, which can be easily detected by ultrasound." **The Search Begins** The Search Begins is a new seven-episode video series adapted from the Augustine Institute's award-winning series The Search, hosted by Christ Stefanick. It is designed to enkindle meaningful discussions with teens searching for answers: What is the meaning of my life? Why am I here? Who am I? Is God real?
