To understand more fully how to defend and protect human life, we must first consider who we are, at the deepest level. God creates us in His image and likeness, which means we are made to be in loving relationship with Him. The essence of our identity and worth, the source of our dignity, is that we are loved by God. As Saint Pope John Paul II used to say: "We are not the sum of our weaknesses and failures; we are the sum of the Father's love for us and our real capacity to become the image of His Son." God's love is the true source of our worth, identity, and dignity.

The knowledge and realization of how deeply we are loved by God impels us to share His love with others. Being a disciple of Jesus naturally includes sharing the Gospel with others and inviting them into a deeper relationship with God. A Christian life lived with charity and faith is the most effective form of evangelization. If we respond to Christ's grace, our lives will show we have something beyond what the world offers: we follow a person whose love changes our lives, so we want others to also experience His transforming love.

When someone is facing great trials, we need to meet them where they are, walk with them on their journey, intercede for them, and be open to sharing Christ's love however He directs. When a woman becomes pregnant, and her boyfriend threatens to leave if she continues the pregnancy, we need to lovingly walk with her. When family members or friends become seriously ill, we need to assure them that God still offers them something in this life, and they still have purpose. When someone struggles with serious habitual sin that offends their dignity or the dignity of others, we want to offer truthful and compassionate help to overcome it. We need to consistently be with our sisters and brothers every step of the way. Sometimes our actions speak for themselves; other times, words are needed. Whatever the situation, Jesus knows how to speak to each person's heart; we simply need to follow where He leads.

This is how we build a culture of life, a culture that joyfully proclaims the truth of God's love, purpose, and plan for each person. Changing the culture is a process of conversion that begins in our own hearts and includes a willingness to be instructed and a desire to be close to Jesus—the source of joy and love. Let us go, therefore, and not be afraid. God is always with us.

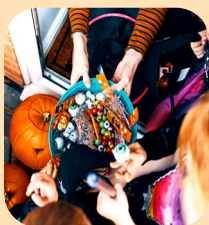

**Did You Know?** Perinatal hospice is a loving option for babies diagnosed with an illness "incompatible with life" or a "life-limiting condition". Support can include counseling, sonograms, photos or mementos of the baby, support groups, a birth plan, a burial plan, and prayer. The study "Perinatal Hospice: A Compassionate, Life-Affirming Option" surveyed 82 mothers in pregnancies with grim diagnoses who were served by a hospice program. 83% said the level of emotional support received was "very supportive" and 86% were highly confident they made the right choice to give birth to their babies.
