## Special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis of Assisi



This year the Franciscan family and all those inspired by Francis of Assisi celebrate the 800th anniversary of his passing from this life to eternal glory on October 3, 1226. In honor of this special occasion, Pope Leo has established a special Jubilee Year, from January 10, 2026, to January 10, 2027.

The Apostolic Penitentiary grants the plenary indulgence under the usual conditions to those who participate devoutly in this extraordinary jubilee. **The grace of this special year is extended to all the**

**faithful who, with their spirits removed from sin, visit in the form of a pilgrimage any Franciscan conventual church (that includes Holy Family Church and the Chapel of the Oldenburg Sisters) or any place of worship dedicated to St. Francis.**

To make your visit a pilgrimage, it should be a special occasion for visiting the church, a significant time set aside for prayer. Have a special intention you will pray about while you are there. Bring the whole family and make a morning or afternoon of it, with prayer in the church and a meal together or other special activity. You may want make a pilgrimage to Holy Family Church on a First Friday, when we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament all day in the main church and Benediction in the evening.

Conditions for receiving the Indulgence for oneself or for the deceased:

(1) *sacramental confession* in the eight days before or after; (2) *participation in Mass and Eucharistic Communion*; (3) visit in the form of a *pilgrimage* to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis, with the *recitation of the Creed, recitation of the Lord's Prayer, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.*

May this Year of St. Francis be for each one of us an occasion for sanctification and evangelical witness in the contemporary world, for the glory of God, and the good of the whole Church.

This week is Catholic Schools Week, an annual celebration of Catholic education in the US. The theme this year is "Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community." This theme emphasizes the role of Catholic schools in fostering a sense of community and faith among students, families, and educators. Please give thanks to God and pray for our Catholic schools and all those who attend and work at them.

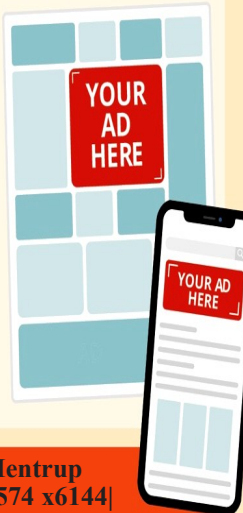
