## Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

### Third Sunday of Easter - April 14, 2024

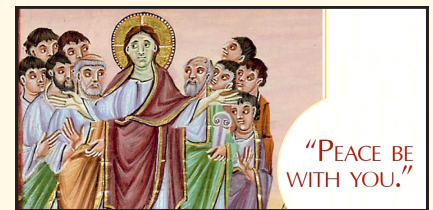
After a good Holy Week and Easter, we celebrated the First Communions of 22 of our young children on Saturday, April 6. A great crowd of family and friends filled the church for the celebration. In a couple weeks, we will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for 29 of our 8<sup>th</sup> graders on April 20 at 3 PM with Archbishop Thompson. Beth Geis and Bro. John are hard at work preparing this annual celebration as well.



On this Third Sunday of Easter, our Scriptures continue to reflect on the meaning and importance of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection for us and our world. The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles tells of St. Peter's preaching about how Jesus has been glorified by God. Even though Jesus was betrayed and put to death, God has raised Him from the dead and the disciples are witnesses. St. Peter admits that the people who called for Jesus' death acted out of ignorance, but

God has used this to fulfill the prophets' words that the Christ would suffer. All are called to repent and be converted. St. John writes to the early Christians assuring them that Jesus offers forgiveness for all our sins and the sins of the world. We are called to keep His commandments.

In St. Luke's Gospel, Jesus appears again to His disciples and offers them His peace. When they thought they were seeing a ghost, Jesus invited them to touch Him and also asked for some baked fish to eat. Jesus assures them that all that happened to Him was to fulfill the prophets and psalms. He helped them understand the Scriptures that He had to die and be raised in order to bring forgiveness for sins to all. Jesus calls them to be witnesses to all the nations, beginning in Jerusalem. How are you witnessing to our world of the love and mercy of Jesus?



I hope you all enjoyed your experience of the total eclipse on Monday, April 8. It was a real life-changing experience, especially for the few minutes of darkness.

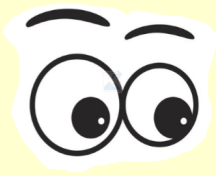

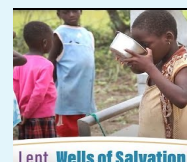
