# Holy Family Parish



*"Simon, son of John, do you love me?" (John 21:16)*

I am struck by how gracious the Risen Lord is to His disciples, most of whom abandoned Him or – in the case of Peter – outright denied knowing Him in His darkest hour. We saw last week that His first words to them were "Peace be with you." This week He calls them "children" and affirms their vocation to catch as many people ("fish") as they can for the Kingdom. He puts His trust in them, despite their failings and weaknesses.

Nowhere is this more touching than in His exchange with Peter. The Apostle who had declared Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God, pretended not to know Him as he warmed himself near a charcoal fire. Now, once again at a charcoal fire, he is offered forgiveness and redemption. Three times he denied Jesus; now three times he is given the opportunity to insist that, in the end, he really does love Him. The gracious Lord not only gives Peter a chance to make up for his failure, but He also affirms his role as pastor of Christ's flock. Jesus entrusts to the once faithless Peter the care of His Church.

We all can point to our failings of discipleship: our infidelities, spiritual laziness, outright rejection of aspects of the Gospel, refusal to make the sacrifices necessary to love God and neighbor. Yet as often as we fail, every time we are given the chance to return to the Lord, to reaffirm our desire to follow Him and to love and be loved by Him. From the death of sin and weakness comes the new life offered by our gracious, merciful Savior. No matter how hard we have stumbled, how far we have wandered, may we always have the confidence to turn back to Him, asking Him to help us follow him more closely as He leads us, His beloved flock, into eternal life.

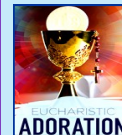
