# Holy Family Parish



“...a great multitude...from every nation, race, people, and tongue” (Revelation 7:9)

Saint John’s visions of heaven in the book of Revelation are filled with people from all over the world. They may look different from each other, speak different languages, and have different customs, but they are all united in their worship of

God. Together that stand before God’s throne and the Lamb (that is, Christ, the victor over death), adoring them day and night, without ceasing.

This is exactly how God wants it to be. From the very beginning, God has sought to bring the whole human race together as a single family united in its life-giving relationship with Him. When God called Abraham, He promised that “all the families of the earth will find blessing in you” (Gen 12:31), and that his descendants would be as numerous as the countless stars in the sky (Gen 15:5). God revealed through Saint Paul that the baptized become children of God and those descendants of Abraham (Romans 4:16).

It is God’s desire that people of all descriptions – everyone of us – should inherit the Kingdom. This is why He sent His Son, and this is why His Son sends us out to announce the Good News and invite others to receive it for themselves. Paul and Barnabas, and many others, worked tirelessly in the early years of the Church to spread the Gospel. They met with severe opposition, but they persevered because they knew they were called to announce and invite. We, too, are called to be missionary disciples in a culture that can be uncomprehending or hostile to “anything Christian.” But we are asked to be faithful, not successful according to any human standards. And so, we ask the Holy Spirit to show us how we are called to “go, and announce the Gospel of the Lord,” and to give us the courage, humility, and perseverance to invite others to join the great multitude that God gathers to Himself.

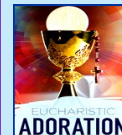

## Young Mothers' New Baby Meal Train

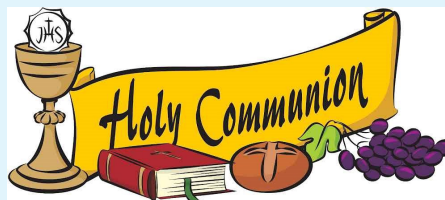

Twenty-eight second graders celebrated their First Holy Communion on Saturday, April 5th!

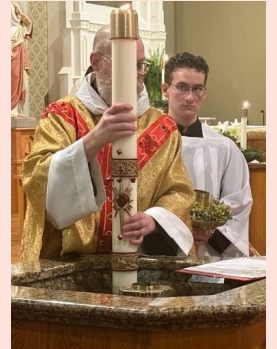
