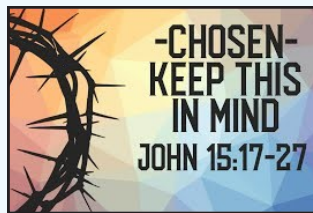
Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Sixth Sunday of Easter - May 5, 2024

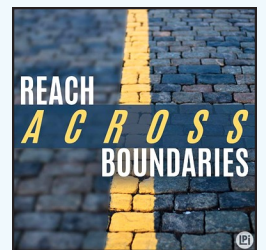
Last week we had another busy week, with the First Communion of Arrow Fasbinder on Saturday afternoon, April 27, followed by Doug Nobbe's Retirement Celebration after the 5:30 PM Mass. On Sunday, April 28, we had coffee, juice, and donuts after the 8 AM Mass, and then the first Baptism by Deacon John of Paisley Elaine Luers at the 10 AM Mass. At all the Masses Mr. Tony Dinkel shared with us some information about the National Eucharistic Congress to be held in Indianapolis on July 17-21. On Wednesday, May 1 at 6:30 we celebrated the May Crowning of Mary at the final Mass for the Religious Education Year. On Saturday afternoon, May 4, we celebrated the Marriage of Justin Garcia and Molly Weigel.



Our Scriptures this weekend continue to develop the themes from our previous weekend after Easter. In the Acts of the Apostles we hear of Peter's interactions with Cornelius. The Church continues to grow among the Gentiles and Peter comments that God shows no partiality between Jews and Gentiles. All people present received the Holy Spirit, Jews and Gentiles alike. Then they were all Baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. St. John's second reading again encourages all to love one another because they know God. God sent His only Son into the world to give us eternal life. God loved us first and sent His Son to forgive us for our sins so that His love may grow in us.



St. John's Gospel continues Jesus' farewell blessing at the Last Supper. Jesus tells the disciples to remain in His love by keeping the Father's Commandments. This love will bring joy to all and this love is evident in those who lay down their lives for their friends, as Jesus commands. Jesus no longer calls us slaves, but rather friends, because He has told us everything He has heard from His Father in heaven. Jesus has chosen His disciples and has appointed them to go forth and bear fruit that will remain. He commands all to love one another. **How do you express this love on a daily basis?**

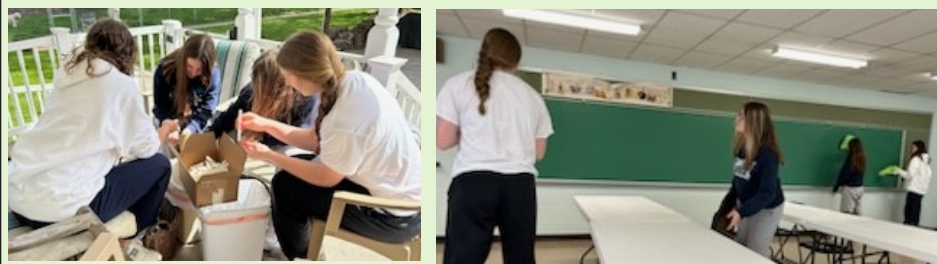
