# Holy Family Parish



"Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." (Luke 6:36)

Sometimes we hear people say that being a Christian is just about being a decent person. True, Christians should be decent people, but according to Jesus, decency isn't even the minimum expectation for His disciples. Jesus tells us that we are to act like Him, and like His Father: giving and giving and giving, forgiving and forgiving and forgiving. Jesus commands us to do

something that no other religion or moral philosophy demands: to love our enemies.

What does it mean to love our enemies? Well, it doesn't mean we have to like them, and it doesn't mean we have to accept without complaint whatever they say or do. Christian love – *agape* – has been called an "unconquerable benevolence." Sometimes the most loving, benevolent thing is to try to stop someone from doing something that is harming them or others. We have a duty to protect others, even those who would harm us, from harm when we can.

Still, we are called to be remarkably patient, just as Jesus and His Father are. This is a very high standard, but it is part of the dignity of the Christian to attempt to live up to it with the help of God's grace. When people hate us or mistreat us, we do good to them, we bless them, and we pray for them. We may seek to change their behavior, but we do not seek revenge. We look to Jesus, especially on Good Friday, to see what being a child of God looks like. All Jesus suffered, all He endured, He did out of love for sinners, very often ungrateful sinners.

There's more. Jesus also teaches us – remarkably, and a little scarily – that we set the standard by which God will treat us. If we forgive others (or at least *try* to), we will be forgiven. If we are merciful, we will experience mercy. But if our hearts are hardened toward others, if we withhold compassion and mercy, if we fail to love even those who do not love us, our souls are not capable of receiving the fullness of God's love and mercy.

We come to Mass not only to worship our merciful and good God, but also to receive the grace and the strength to follow Jesus in the path of Christian love. This is our calling, and it is a high one, and we need all the help we can get. Let's ask the Holy Spirit to show us where we might be holding out on loving others, and seek the grace to become more like God, our Father.

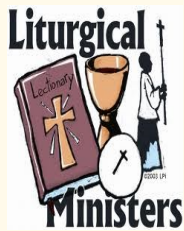

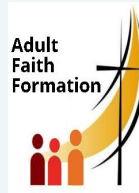
