Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Second Sunday of Easter, April 16, 2023

Thanks to all who joined us for the beautiful celebrations of Holy Week and Easter. We had a good crowd for Holy Thursday's Mass of the Lord's Supper including the

washing of feet. On Friday we had an even larger congregation for the reading of the Passion, the Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. Saturday's Easter Vigil Mass with the blessing of the new fire and Paschal Candle, and Salvation History readings went well. Then the renewal of Baptismal Promises & the reception of our 3 RCIA Candidates into the Church, with their Confirmation and




First Communion were celebrated. And last but not least, we had overflowing crowds for our Easter Sunday Masses. Thanks to our musicians, our choir, our many ministers, our decorators, and our presiders, especially Fr. Joe and Fr. Mike.



Today we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter, also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. We continue to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus, with a special emphasis on Jesus' love and mercy for all people. The inscription under the Divine Mercy picture of the rays of love coming from Jesus' heart reads, "Jesus I Trust in You!" This feastday was announced by Pope St. John Paul II on April 30, 2000, when he canonized St. Faustina. She had received a series of revelations in the 1930s, reminding people that Jesus is a refuge and shelter for all people, especially sinners.

Our Scriptures for this Sunday continue to tell us about the Risen Jesus and the community's response to the Resurrection. The Acts of the Apostles describes the early believers and how they prayed and shared all things in common. Every day the

Lord added to their numbers. St. Peter in the second reading prays to God, giving thanks for Jesus' resurrection. The people are called to rejoice even in the midst of their suffering, knowing that their belief in the risen Jesus is the source of their salvation. St. John's Gospel tells of Jesus' appearance to the disciples that evening of the Resurrection, when He sends them forth to preach and forgive sins. Thomas was absent and refused to believe unless he could



touch Jesus' wounds. A week later Jesus again appears to them, including Thomas. This time Thomas believes, and Jesus invites him and all people to believe, even without seeing. So we can relate to Thomas' doubt and his new faith.



We want to congratulate our 26 Second Graders who received their First Communion on Saturday, April 15, at 1 PM. Thanks to Beth & their teachers who helped prepare them for this special day, as well as their parents, the first teachers of their children in the faith. May they continue to grow in their faith and love for Jesus!







EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS



Due to the constant unchecked flow of data and information through the Internet, it can be hard to know when a story is real news or rubbish. It never ceases to amaze me when someone I know has bought into some crazy fake news story. Sometimes the story is just so unbelievable: celebrities who gained two hundred pounds in a month, women having babies who were never pregnant, or people

actually being seen who are dead! Like Elvis! The apostle Thomas found the news that Jesus was alive just too far-fetched to believe. But he didn't first hear the news on the Internet or read it standing in the grocery store checkout line. His friends told him. His fellow apostles told him they had actually seen the Lord with their own eyes. Their testimony was not enough. He needed proof. The resurrection of Jesus gives us not only hope, but also a reason to be his disciples. We have not seen with our own eyes but, like Thomas, we have a community, the Church, that has relayed the truth to us. This same Jesus now calls us to go forth to spread the Gospel.
