

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Fourth Sunday of Easter, April 30, 2023

Hopefully we will have some new volunteers to become Eucharistic Ministers in time for our resuming Communion under both species, the Consecrated Bread and

the Consecrated Wine, on Mother's Day, May 14. We are having workshops for the veterans and new ministers on April 27 (already past) and Thursday, May 11, at 6:30 PM in order to prepare for Mother's Day weekend and beyond. We will be having 2 cups along with the 4 plates to begin with, and if the response is great, we will then have 4 Communion Ministers with



cups and 4 with plates. Please consider serving your fellow parishioners in this way as Eucharistic Ministers. All who have been Confirmed are eligible.

I will be going to our St. Francis Retreat House in Easton, PA., from May 1 to 5 for



a Guardian's Convocation. As we form 1 new US Province named "Our Lady of Guadalupe," we are asked to review and renew our understanding what it means to be a Guardian or Local Minister in our Franciscan Friaries. The new Our Lady of Guadalupe Province begins officially on October 17, 2023, with our Chapter Meeting of Unification in Kansas City, MO. The friars from 6 US Provinces will become one Province, with about 700 members, headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia.

Much work and many meetings are underway to prepare for this new province, its administration, and many offices and committees. Please keep us in your prayers.

This weekend we celebrate the 4th Sunday of Easter, and we continue to reflect on the meaning and implication of Jesus' life, death, and Resurrection. St. Peter is still preaching on Pentecost Sunday, and answers the people's questions about what to

do in response to all Jesus did for us. Peter tells them to "Repent and be Baptized . . . in the name of Jesus Christ . . . and receive the Holy Spirit." That is our call, too. Our second reading encourages us to be patient in suffering, because Christ suffered for us even though He was innocent. By His wounds we were healed and He is our shepherd. St. John's Gospel picks up on the theme of Jesus as our Shepherd and Sheep Gate. We are



called to enter through Him, and thus we are protected and saved through Him. He says, "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly." May we continue to grow in our belief and appreciation of Jesus as our Shepherd and Savior.



Congratulations to all of our Graduates, Eighth Graders and Seniors. We celebrate them and their families this weekend with special recognition at the 10 AM Sunday Mass and a graduation breakfast afterwards, hosted by the Knights of St. John.




