

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord, April 9, 2023

A Most Blessed and Glorious Happy Easter to you all! May the Risen Lord be with you & bless you in a special way as we celebrate His Resurrection this Easter Sunday! Lent is over & it is now time to again reflect on the fact that the Eternal Bridegroom is with us! Jesus is our source of joy and hope in our troubled world!



We congratulate our 22 Eighth Graders who were Confirmed by Archbishop Thompson on Saturday, April 1. May they continue to grow in the Holy Spirit and their




commitment as adults in the Church. We also congratulate our RCIA Candidates who received the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist at our Easter Vigil Mass: Cassie Wratten, Whitney Lambert, and Meg Noble-Rauch. Thanks to all who joined us on Holy Saturday night at the Easter Vigil, this once-a-year extended celebration with the

Blessing of the New Fire and Paschal Candle, Scripture readings regarding Salvation History, Confirmation and First Holy Communion for our RCIA folks. Today we celebrate Jesus' Rising from the Grave in Glory!

Our Easter Scriptures begin with St. Peter in Acts of the Apostles recounting what Jesus did while alive in Galilee and Judea. How Jesus preached and healed with the power of the Holy Spirit. How Jesus was crucified and rose from the dead on the third

day. How He commissioned the disciples to preach & testify to Jesus' love and forgiveness. St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians encourages them to seek what is above, where Jesus is seated at the right hand of God, and reminds them how they will appear with Jesus in glory. The Gospel from St. John tells of Mary of Magdala going to the open tomb, then running to tell Peter and the Disciple Jesus loved. They ran to the tomb and saw the burial cloths and empty tomb. Then



they believed that Jesus was truly risen from the dead. The empty tomb and the discarded burial cloths are all the evidence they need. How does Jesus' life, death, and Resurrection challenge us to live lives of love, compassion, mercy and forgiveness? Do we attempt to model our daily living according to the example of Jesus and the disciples? How can we deepen our faith in Jesus and the Resurrection

as we celebrate Easter again this year?

We offer our condolences and promise our prayers to the family of Helen Rose Enneking, whose funeral Mass and burial were celebrated this past Friday, March 31, at Holy Family Church. May she rest in peace and may her family be consoled.



Lectors: Lectors make the Living Word of God present by their proclamation during the Liturgy of the Word. They are trained to help the congregation to better understand the scripture & to successfully communicate the message to the people. 
