# Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Easter Sunday of The Resurrection, March 31, 2024


A Happy and Glorious Easter to you all! We want to congratulate our RCIA participants this year who are completing their entrance into the Catholic Church this

Easter weekend. The Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday night is the great occasion. Our Candidate who is receiving his Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist is Jarron Koenemann. Our Elect who are receiving all their Sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist, are

Our first Easter Sunday reading is from the Acts of the Apostles. It summarizes Jesus' ministry of preaching and healing. It goes on to tell how Jesus was crucified




and how God raised Him on the third day. Jesus appeared to many witnesses whom He commissioned to preach and to testify that He is appointed by God to judge the living and the dead. All who believe in Him will receive forgiveness of their sins. The second reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians. St. Paul encourages these new believers to seek what is heavenly, where Jesus

reigns. They are not to be concerned about the things of earth, since they have died to sin and temptation. They can look forward to glory with Christ.

Our Gospel is from St. John and recounts the events of Easter morning when Mary

of Magdala came to Jesus' tomb. She was surprised to see the stone rolled away from the tomb and ran to tell Peter and John. She announced that Jesus' body had been taken away and they don't know where to look for Him. Peter and the other apostle ran to the tomb and found it empty, with the burial cloths there. Peter saw the cloths and didn't know what to think. The other disciple went into the tomb and saw and believed. They still did not understand that Jesus had to rise from the dead. How do



you respond to the news that Jesus is risen? Do you doubt the truth of the Gospel story or are you a convinced believer in Jesus' Resurrection?




