Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Feast of the Ascension of the Lord - May 12, 2024

I'd like to wish a Happy Mother's Day to all our Mothers, Grandmothers, and Mothers-to-Be on this Mother's Day! We all have much to be thankful for because of our Mother's love and care for us! May God continue to bless them on their special day! Don't forget



about our Mother's Day breakfast from 8:45 to 10 AM on Sunday morning.

You have probably heard the news by now that I am retiring from being the Pastor of Holy Family Parish, effective August 24, after Bro John Barker is



Ordained on Friday, August 23. He will be assigned here as Pastor on August 24. Another priest, Fr. E.J. Stein will also be assigned here to help with Masses. etc. Fr. Mike will continue here and will become the Guardian of the Friary as well. It is with some sadness that I announce this change, but I feel that it is also time

for me to retire, and the Provincial authorities agreed with me. My residence is still to be determined, probably in Cincinnati.

For the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord the Church gives us special readings. Acts 1:1-11 tells about Jesus' ministry during 40 days after His Resurrection. He preached about the Kingdom of God and the coming Baptism with the Holy Spirit. Jesus promises that they will receive power from the Holy Spirit to be His witnesses to the ends of the earth. Then Jesus was taken up into the heavens. In the Letter to the Ephesians, St. Paul says that God will give them a Spirit of wisdom and revelation that they may know His glory and power. God raised Jesus



from the dead and seated Him at God's right hand. Jesus is now the head of the Church and fulfills all that the prophets promised.

St. Mark's Gospel passage describes Jesus' mandate that the disciples are to go throughout the world preaching and baptizing so that people can be saved. Great signs will accompany the preachers and believers and they will have special powers, including healing the sick. After speaking to the people, Jesus was taken



up into heaven and was seated at God's right hand. The believers went and preached everywhere and God confirmed their teachings with great signs. What is your reaction to Jesus' Ascension? Do you understand that now it is your responsibility to continue Jesus' ministry of

spreading the Good News throughout the world? Jesus came to save all people through you! Your words and example and prayers are important!


