## Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

### Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time, February 12, 2023

I am on retreat in McAllen, Texas, this weekend, with a visit to the border with Mexico to see the conditions there and how the people are being ministered to. So I am writing these reflections a week early, hoping that I don't miss anything important. I want to thank everyone who worked so hard preparing, cooking, and putting the Mock-Turtle soup in their containers this past week. I also want to thank everyone who purchased our Turtle Soup from the Village Store to help support our Religious Ed Programs. Once again you have come through with flying colors.

Our Scriptures this weekend focus on being faithful to the Covenant & obeying the Commandments in deed and thought. Sirach tells us that we will be saved by choosing to obey the commandments and trusting in God. We need to choose between life and death, good and evil. God is mighty and all-seeing; He understands our every deed and He never asks us to choose evil or sin. St. Paul speaks to the Corinthians about God's wisdom which is for our glory. He says if

the earthly rulers had known this wisdom, they would never have crucified Jesus. God has revealed His wisdom to us through the Spirit. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus says He has



not come to abolish the law and the prophets, but to fulfill them. Therefore we should not break them in deed or even in thought. It is not enough not to kill, we should not become exceedingly angry. We should be reconciled before coming to church to offer our sacrifice at the altar. Nor should we commit adultery or even look with lust at another person. Divorce is forbidden as well and a divorced person is off limits for marriage. False oaths or swearing are forbidden; "Yes" means "yes," and "No" means "no!" Nothing else should be required.
