Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, February 19, 2023

It's Tuesday morning, and I just returned from my retreat in San Juan, Texas, on the campus of the Basilica of the National Shrine of Our Lady of San Juan Del Valle. It is a beautiful shrine similar to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico. Pilgrims are praying there at all times of the day in front of the Virgin's statue or walking the Way of the Cross outside. Our retreat director was Fr. Caoimhin (Kevin) O Laoide, OFM, an Irish friar who is leading the process of our 6 Franciscan Provinces joining together in October of this year. We reflected on many Church and Franciscan issues, especially 8 Synodality.



After the retreat was over, some of us had the chance to visit the border with Mexico and see what is being done by many Christian churches to serve the needs of the refugees on both sides of the border. We were impressed by Sr. Norma Pimentel and her staff who operate several migrant camps and facilities in both Reynosa, Mexico, and



McAllen, Texas. They provide food, housing in tents, medical care, and opportunities to contact families and sponsors in our country. They staff the Catholic

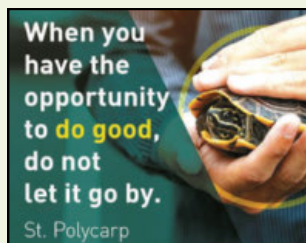


Charities Humanitarian Respite Center in McAllen, Texas, which helps families complete the application forms for their hearings by the immigrations officials. Sr. Norma has a good relationship with the

Border Patrol and other government officials, and they work together for the good of the migrants and refugees. It is not a hostile relationship and they all respect Sr. Norma and her work for the people. I found her attitude and trust in God and God's people admirable and humbling, a good example for us.



On this 7th Sunday, Leviticus gives us some good advice and direction regarding love of neighbor and family. We are not to take revenge or cherish grudges but to love our neighbor



as ourselves. St. Paul reminds the Corinthians and us that we are temples of God and the Spirit of God dwells in us. Therefore we are not to destroy other people because they, too, are holy. The wisdom of this world is foolishness in the eyes of God. We all belong to Christ and Christ to God! In St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tells us not to offer resistance to one who is evil, but to turn the other cheek. We should be generous to anyone in need who wants to borrow from us.

Again, Jesus says we are to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us. All are children of God, who rains on the just and the unjust. We need to do more than love those who love us; we are to be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect: to be our best possible selves.

We offer our sympathy and the promise of our prayers to the family of Sandra "Sandy" Koch whose funeral Mass was here at Holy Family Church on Tuesday, Feb 14, with Fr. Mike. May she rest in peace and may her family and friends be consoled.
