

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections First Sunday of Lent, February 26, 2023

I would like to share some good news with all of our parishioners and friends! We are going to have a new friar living with us at Holy Family Parish for the next year!

His name is Brother John Barker. He is 57 years old and has been a Franciscan Brother for 22 years. He is very talented and well educated. Besides his undergrad degree, he has a Master of Divinity degree and a PhD in Holy Scripture. He taught Scripture at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago to graduate students for a number of years before going to Jamaica to work in the Franciscan missions there. He will be able to help us in a number of areas, including teaching adult ed, helping with RCIA, perhaps doing



Baptismal and Marriage preparation, and working in the parish, etc. He will be arriving soon. Please make him feel welcome and at home at Holy Family Parish!

Today is the First Sunday of Lent, so our Scriptures take on a new tone & direction. Our first reading from the Book of Genesis tells the familiar story of the fall of the first woman & man after being tempted by the serpent in the Garden of Eden. Adam and Eve disobeyed God's order not to eat of the tree in the middle of the garden & soon discovered that they were naked. They felt shame for the first time & covered themselves with fig leaves. St. Paul tells the Corinthians & us that death was the result of their sin. But the obedience of Jesus Christ brought about acquittal & the




new life of grace and justification for all people who believe. In the Gospel of St. Matthew, Jesus is led into the desert by the devil to undergo several temptations as He begins His public life. He is tempted to turn stones into bread, to throw Himself down off the temple, and the devil invited Him to worship evil in exchange for earthly riches. Jesus rejected all

these temptations and expressed His full trust in God. The temptations are symbols of greed, doubt, and pride, temptations we all experience. Jesus shows us how to overcome our temptations and remain true to our calling as faithful Christians. May this season of Lent be a source of conversion, strength and growth in holiness for all of us through our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

We are planning a special project for our parish for Lent this year. We want to help

support the Cross Catholic Outreach's "Wells of Salvation" project. The goal during this Lent is to gather funds to help build 69 clean water wells for communities in Ghana, Malawi, and Zambia. People in these countries do not have access to clean water for drinking, cooking and bathing, but have to gather water from polluted streams or mud puddles and carry it miles to their huts. Please join us during this



penitential season to help these poor people. More information will be forthcoming.



When a family finds out they are having a miscarriage, they should not have to also worry about having an appropriate burial vessel for when the miscarriage happens.

Covenant Resources assembles

miscarriage totes for facilities (hospitals, doctor offices, funeral homes, pregnancy resource centers) that allow a woman to go into that facility and leave with the supplies she needs without waiting for them to arrive in the mail. Covenant Resources does not charge to assemble the totes and does not make any profit. However, there are \$150 worth of supplies in each tote which will help multiple families. Many facilities want the totes, but it is often daunting for them to acquire funding to purchase them. Please consider purchasing a tote (or part of a tote) that can be given to a facility near you. BATESVILLE Did You Know? At 6 weeks a preborn baby is NOT PREGNANCY HOTLINE just a clump of cells. According to Dr. Tara Sander Lee. senior fellow and director of life sciences at the nonprofit

Charlotte Lozier Institute, "A preborn baby's heart is actively beating at 6 weeks and will have already beat nearly 16 million times by 15 weeks. In fact, at 6 weeks' gestation, the baby's heart rate is about 110 beats per minute, which can be easily detected by ultrasound."
