Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, February 5, 2023

On this Fifth Sunday, the image of light plays a big part in our Scriptures. Isaiah calls the Israelites to shine like the light of dawn by feeding the hungry, caring for the homeless, and clothing the naked. Then the Lord will answer their call for help, and it will become for them like midday. St. Paul's Letter to the Corinthians continues to explain his commitment to Jesus Christ while he preached to them through the power of the Holy Spirit. St. Matthew's Gospel continues Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. Jesus calls his disciples and us to be like salt and light: we are to make a difference in our world by our good deeds, so that others may glorify our heavenly Father. How are we making a difference in Oldenburg and Batesville through our gracious attitudes and unselfish deeds right here at home?








handling the sales of the soup for us.




