Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Fifth Sunday of Lent, March 17, 2024

This past Sunday we had the Second Scrutiny for our RCIA Elect, Courtney Bruns and Jozie Koenemann, at the 10 AM Mass. We used the Year A Readings for this



Mass because they have themes that apply to our Elect. Last week the theme was how water brings life, especially the waters of Baptism. The woman at the well received 'living water' from Jesus. The Gospel told about Jesus healing the man born blind



and how faith brings the light of Jesus into his life and ours. This week's 'A' Gospel is about the raising of Lazarus & Jesus giving us everlasting life.

We also had the Confirmation Candidates and their Sponsors at our 10 AM Mass. It was the day of their Confirmation Retreat in preparation for the day they will receive their Sacrament of Confirmation from Archbishop Thompson on Saturday, April 20th. Please pray for them during these last weeks of preparation. We support them as they prepare!

Our Year B readings for this week emphasize the coming of a new Covenant and



how Jesus will bring this about. Jeremiah in the first reading tells the people that God will write the new Covenant on their hearts, rather than on tablets of stone. All the chosen people will know the Lord, because God will forgive their sins and remember their sins no more. The passage from the Letter to the Hebrews reminds the people that Jesus offered reverent prayers to God and

learned obedience from His sufferings. Jesus is the source of eternal salvation for all who obey Him. We celebrate Him as our eternal High Priest.

Our Gospel reading is from St. John's Gospel, and tells about the Greek believers coming to Philip, wanting to see Jesus. Jesus says His hour has come when He will

be glorified. Jesus uses the image of the grain of wheat that has to "die" and be buried before it can grow and bear fruit. Whoever wants to bear fruit and be saved must lose their life in this world by following Jesus. Whoever serves Jesus must follow Him, and He will be with His servant. The Father will honor whoever serves Jesus in this world. Jesus goes on to

say that He came into this world to serve the Father and glorify His name, even though it involves suffering. The Father speaks from heaven that He will glorify Jesus in His suffering, and this is for the benefit of Jesus' followers. Jesus goes on to say that when He rises, He will draw everyone to Himself. How do I understand Jesus' sufferings on my behalf? Do I appreciate what Jesus has done for me through His life, death, and resurrection?




