## **Mass in Honor of Saint Francis of Assisi**

Please join us on Saturday, May 30, at 10am for a special Mass to commemorate the 800th anniversary of the passing of Saint Francis of Assisi. In honor of this anniversary, the Holy Father has established this year as a special Jubilee Year and given the opportunity to gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions to all the faithful who, with their spirits removed from sin, visit in the form of a pilgrimage any Franciscan conventual church (that includes Holy Family Church and the Chapel of the Oldenburg Sisters) or any place of worship dedicated to St. Francis. This Mass is the perfect opportunity to gain the Indulgence! We will also be celebrating the final vows of members of the Order of Secular Franciscans.

Conditions for receiving the Indulgence for oneself or for the deceased include: (1) *sacramental confession* in the eight days before or after; (2) *participation in Mass and Eucharistic Communion*; (3) *visit in the form of a pilgrimage* any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis, with the *recitation of the Creed, recitation of the Lord's Prayer, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father*. You will be able to fulfill of these conditions by participating in this Mass (opportunity for confession will be available here before the Mass, as well as throughout the week before and after the Mass, during the usual times). A plenary indulgence also requires that we have no attachment to sin, which means that we have made the commitment to forsake, with the help of God's grace, all that the Church has defined as a sin.

## **Saturday Mass Time**

Based on the results of last weekend's poll of the parish, the Saturday Mass time will remain at 4:30 throughout the year. Of the 162 ballots submitted, 76% preferred the earlier time all year.

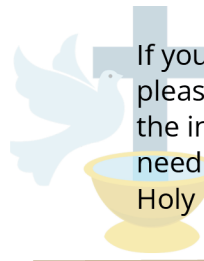
