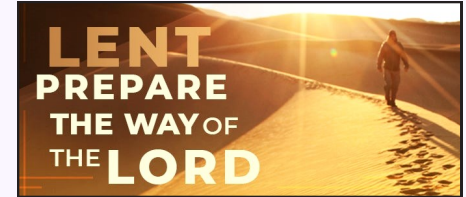

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

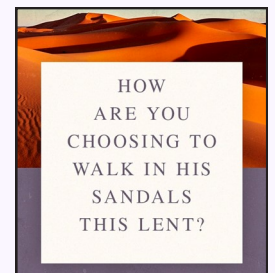
First Sunday of Lent, February 18, 2024

As you know, we began the Season of Lent on Ash Wednesday, February 14 of this past week. Our liturgical celebrations now take on a new emphasis, as we prepare for the feast of Easter, with Holy Week leading up to it. Preparation for Baptism is the focus for our Catechumens in the RCIA program; and for us who are already Baptized, it is a time for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, a 40-day season for repentance & reflection. Fridays are to be days of fasting for those 18-59 & abstinence from meat for those 14 & older.



The Scriptures for this first week of Lent emphasize God's Covenant with His people and Jesus' beginning His public life. The reading from the Book of Genesis tells of the time after Noah and his family left the ark along with all the animals. God promised never again to destroy all living things by a flood, and made a Covenant with Noah to that effect. The rainbow is to be a sign of God's love and care for creation. The First Letter of Peter tells of how Jesus suffered for sins in order to lead us to God. Peter reminds us that Baptism is prefigured by Noah's experience with the flood water, and that Baptism saves us now. Baptism does not remove dirt from the body, but is an appeal to God for our salvation brought about by Jesus' resurrection from the dead.

St. Mark describes Jesus' being driven out into the desert where He was tempted by Satan for 40 days. Angels ministered to Him, and after John the Baptist was arrested, Jesus began His life of public ministry. Jesus preached that the Kingdom of God was at hand, so all should repent and believe in the good news of the Gospel. How do we respond to Jesus' call to us to repent? Are we going to go beyond our usual penances of giving up candy or smoking or drinking or gossip, just to go back to our old habits after Easter? What positive actions are we going to



do this Lent to help spread the Gospel and grow in our love for our brothers and sisters in the Lord? We have copies of the Magnificat Lenten book with its reflections and suggestions for us.

Congratulations to Hallie Jean Moore, daughter of Deven and Alex (Jones) Moore, who was Baptized at Holy Family on Saturday, February 10, 2024. May she and her family grow closer to God and to each other through the grace and love of Jesus.

We offer our sympathy and the promise of our prayers to the family of Philip E. Hoegeman whose funeral Mass was celebrated here at Holy Family on Monday, February 12. May he rest in peace and may his family be consoled.
