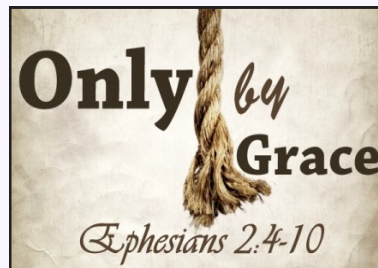
Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Fourth Sunday of Lent, March 10, 2024

This week we will have the Second Scrutiny for our RCIA Catechumens and Candidate. These Scrutinies are part of the process of preparing to be admitted into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night. Deacon John and Beth will be leading the Scrutiny during the 10 AM Mass, along with me. This Sunday is called Laetare Sunday because we are already in the middle of Lent. "Laetare" means rejoice or be joyful. We are permitted to wear rose vestments to show that we are rejoicing.

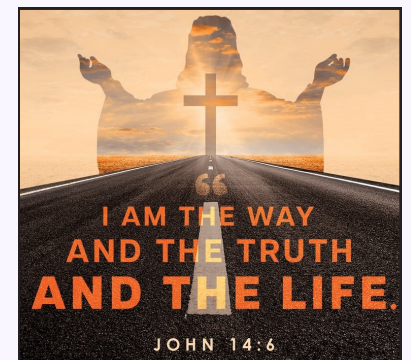


Our Scriptures for this 4th Sunday speak to us about the importance of being faithful to the Covenant and our commitment to God and His mercy. The Second Book of Chronicles tells how the Israelite leaders, the priests, and the people had sinned. As a result, the temple and all of Jerusalem were destroyed by the Babylonians and the people were carried off to Babylon as slaves. Only when the Persians conquered the Babylonians were the people released and freed to return to Jerusalem to rebuild. God had used the people's enemies to punish them, and then to release them from that punishment of slavery. St. Paul's Letter to the



Ephesians tells of God's mercy toward His people, and how He sent His Son Jesus to save them by His grace. It is through faith in Jesus that they were saved; not by their works. Salvation is a gift from God, so no one can boast about their own efforts.

Our Gospel today is the famous passage from St. John's Gospel, Jn 3:16. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life." Again we are reminded that God did not want to punish us, but to save us for eternal life with Him. If anyone was to be condemned, it was because of their own preference for darkness and evil. They refuse to come to the Light; but whoever lives the truth comes to the Light and their works are clearly done in God. Jesus explains all this to Nicodemus, one of the Jewish leaders who was interested in knowing more about Jesus and the Kingdom. Where is the dark in my life, and how can I better move toward the Light, God and Jesus?



We thank our visiting speaker, Erika Kvak, who spoke at the end of Mass about our parish Lenten project, "The Wells of Salvation."
