

# Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 22, 2023

This weekend we are asked to pray for the protection and support of women who are pregnant, and for their unborn children. The Respect Life movement is alive and

well in our country, even after Roe vs Wade was reversed. Women still need help with their problem pregnancies, and the Christian community is challenged to make all life a priority, from womb to tomb, including the elderly, prisoners, refugees, and immigrants.

We are also in the midst of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, which runs from January 18 to January 25. Christ prays that we may all become one, unified in our desire for unity, not necessarily uniformity. Please pray for unity among all Christians.



Our Scriptures again this weekend come from the Prophet Isaiah, St. Paul, and St. Matthew. Isaiah reviews the Israelites' struggle to be faithful to the Covenant. He says that the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. God has



brought them great joy by smashing the yoke that burdened them, their sins and selfishness. St. Paul urges the Corinthians to be united without any divisions or rivalries. All belong to Christ and Christ is not divided. Christ was crucified for all and sent Paul to preach the Gospel to all, Jews and Gentiles. Matthew tells us that after John the Baptist was imprisoned, Jesus went to live in Capernaum to fulfill what we heard from Isaiah in the first reading: "the

people who walk in darkness have seen a great light." Jesus, the light, is preaching repentance to prepare for God's Kingdom. He also invites Peter and Andrew, James and John, to become his disciples. They leave their boats and nets to become "fishers of men." How are we following Jesus' call to us at this time?
