

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 29, 2023

We're having a real winter snowfall or two this week, as we look forward to the Superbowl and the games leading up to it. The contestants have yet to be decided, so there's lots of anticipation in the air! The Bengals won their game against Buffa-Io this past Sunday, so they will be playing Kansas City this Sunday for the AFC championship. Also, this week the Turtle Soup makers will be hard at work, preparing for the winter fund raiser for our Religious Education Programs. In our Scriptures, the Prophet Zephaniah speaks to us about the "remnant" that will remain faithful to God's Covenant when the Israelites are conquered by their enemies. They are encouraged to continue to observe God's law, even if difficult. St. Paul reminds the Corinthians that God chooses ordinary people to shame the wise and



strong in regard to fidelity to Christ Jesus' teaching and example. "Whoever boasts, should boast in the Lord." St. Matthew's Gospel gives us the Beatitudes, the first part of his Sermon on the Mount. Some people call the Beatitudes a "job description" or "blueprint" for






