Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 2, 2023

We continue to celebrate our summer Sundays in Ordinary Time. In the Second Book of Kings, we read about Elisha the prophet, and how he was cared

for by a woman of influence. She hosted him whenever he passed by, and he rewarded her and her husband with the promise of a baby son in the coming year. St. Paul writing to the Romans tells of the benefits of Baptism. In celebrating Baptism, we are dying to sin and rising to new life with Christ. So we must think of ourselves as dead to sin and alive for God in Christ Jesus. In St. Matthew's Gospel



passage, we are challenged to have our priorities in proper order: nothing and no one is more important than Jesus. We must love Jesus above all things and all people, even our families. Whoever receives Jesus, receives the One who sent Jesus, our loving God. We are to be like Jesus, proclaiming God's love for all, even the little ones, by at least giving a cold cup of water to the thirsty. We have the opportunity to work at the Food Pantry during the Wednesdays of July, thus fulfilling Jesus command.


