Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 23, 2023

Thanks, also, to those who worked during the festival and those who participated in it on Friday and Saturday. Finally, thanks to those who spent a couple days gathering the recycling and cleaning up the grounds after all was over! God blessed us with good (hot) weather and also a little rain to keep us on



our toes! Hopefully all went home healthy and refreshed, if a little tired but grateful.



Thanks also to our Rummage Sale committee who have worked hard the past few months to get ready for this weekend's annual Rummage Sale. Our Religious Education Program appreciates all your work and the economic benefits that come from all the donations, preparations, and sales. This week some of that money goes to our Vacation Bible School for the benefit of our children. Thanks to those volunteers as well.

Since I will be on vacation during the next 2 weeks, visiting the Smokey Mountains and friends in Georgia, I will try to make today's Scripture reflections good and complete for your benefit. In the first reading, the Book of Wisdom proclaims God's care over all creation. It is a source of justice and evidence of God's power over all He has made. God shows His might when necessary, but judges with clemency and much leniency. He teaches people to be kind and gives us grounds for hope for forgiveness. St. Paul's Letter to the Romans reminds us that the Spirit helps us weak humans to pray as we ought. The Spirit also intercedes for us, the holy ones, according to God's will.

This week St. Matthew's Gospel presents us with several parables about God's Kingdom. Jesus compares it to a field in which good seed was planted, but weeds also appeared, the work of an enemy. The householder's slaves wanted to pull up the weeds, but the owner (God) said to let them grow until harvest, then they would be removed and burned. God lets the good and the bad live together in our world until



the final judgment; God then decides what our eternal reward will be. The Kingdom is also like the tiny mustard seed that grows into a large plant. And it is like the tiny yeast which helps 3 measures of flour to rise before baking. God's Kingdom starts out small, but gradually grows large, thanks to God's power and our cooperation.

Thanks, again, to all our generous and dedicated parishioners who make this parish the good and holy community that it is. Without your regular support of time, talent, and treasure, we would not be able to grow into healthy believers. Thanks to Frs. Mike & Joe and the staff for all their generous work while I am gone on vacation!







THE BIBLE & BAPTISM In

this six-episode book study, Dr. John Sehorn, Academic Dean of the Augustine Institute Graduate School of Theology, sits down with Fr. Isaac Morales, OP, a Dominican friar of the Province of Saint Joseph and Associate Professor of Theology




