Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 30, 2023

Thanks to all who participated in the Vacation Bible School this past week while I was gone on vacation to the Smokey Mountains and beyond. The theme of the Vacation Bible School was an outer space theme: "God is Out of This World," symbolized by stars and rocket ships and space telescopes. We appreciate all the children and volunteers who made this fun event possible, especially Beth Geis and the other leaders and planners.



This week the Scriptures speak to us of the importance of Wisdom. Solomon, the son of King David, wishes to follow in his father's footsteps. He prays for the necessary qualities to be a good and just king: namely, an understanding heart; **not** a long life, or riches, or the defeat of his enemies. God then blesses him with a wise and understanding heart so that he may truly serve his people. St. Paul writes to the Romans that God calls us according to His purpose. Since He calls us, He justifies us and He glorifies us. All of this enables us to be conformed to the image of God's Son, Jesus. In St. Matthew's Gospel we hear more of Jesus' parables about the Kingdom of heaven. He teaches that the Kingdom is like a buried



treasure or a fine pearl (the pearl of great price). It is worth all that we have and can give to attain it. The Kingdom is like a net thrown into the sea which collects fish of every kind. The good ones are kept and put into buckets, and the bad are thrown away. It is up to us to follow God's will and devote our lives and talents to what is most worthwhile

We congratulate Beth Geis and some of our Youth Group members who recently completed their Mission Trip to Grand Rapids, Michigan. They spent the week with lots of other youth from this area, working to help the less fortunate residents repair and repaint their homes and landscape their lawns. They also built their own Christian community in the process.

Learning is always an opportunity and a gift for which we are grateful. May the Lord be with each student and teacher and parent, so that all may work together during the new school year.




