

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 25, 2023

As we continue with the Sundays of Ordinary Time, this week's Scriptures again emphasize God's care for His people. Jeremiah declares that the Lord is with him and will overcome his persecutors and put them to shame. St. Paul writing to the Romans reminds them and us that the grace of God, evident in Jesus's life, death, and resurrection, has overcome all sin from Adam until now. In St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus tells the 12 apostles to fear no one. They are not to be afraid





of those who kill the body, but rather those who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. Nothing happens without the Father's knowledge. Do we trust God in the ways we are called to do? Do we believe that God is in control of our lives and our world, if we cooperate?


