

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Third Sunday of Lent, March 12, 2023

On this Third Sunday of Lent, our Scriptures are filled with themes and important

lessons. The Book of Exodus describes the concerns and fears of the newly released exiles from Egypt as they begin their long journey through the desert to the Promised Land. Their first complaint was the lack of water, and Moses was instructed by God to use his staff to strike the rock in Horeb. Moses struck it and water flowed out, showing that God was with them and responsive to their needs. St. Paul reminds the Romans and us that we are justified by faith, not works. Jesus' grace is the source of our



salvation & gives us hope because the love of God is poured into us through the Holy Spirit. While we were still sinners, Jesus died for us and then rose on Easter morning.

The Gospel of John tells us of Jesus' promising the Samaritan woman living water, after Jesus asks her for a drink from the well. Their conversation reveals not only her past life, but her growth in faith and trust in Jesus, eventually referring to Him as the



Messiah. She even goes into the town and witnesses to Jesus' love and acceptance, & the people come to believe in Jesus as their Savior. The disciples are shocked by Jesus' going beyond the customs of the time as He dialogues alone with the single woman and reveals His compassion & mercy. John leads us to go deeper, to reflect on Jesus' mercy &

challenge for the woman and us. The living water is a reference to the grace of Baptism & God's loving mercy for all. This Gospel is used to prepare RCIA Catechumens for the Sacrament of Baptism and to remind us all of the importance of Baptism as the source of our grace and strength in Jesus as God's Son.

Please keep in mind our Lenten Parish Mission with Fr. Charlie Smiech coming up in another week, March 20-22. There will be a morning session at 10 AM in church, and an evening session at 7 PM. Each day will have a different theme, and we will hear Confessions after the sessions on Tuesday. Wednesday's talks will be about healing & we



will have the Anointing of the Sick afterwards. We will also have the Anointing of the Sick after the Masses on the weekend, March 25 & 26 for those who wish.

Our Parish Lenten Project is collecting funds for the Cross Catholic Outreach for the "Wells of Salvation." The goal is to help them build clean water wells for people in Ghana, Malawi, and Zambia. Your almsgiving donations are to be sent to Holy Family



Church, mentioning the Wells of Salvation intention which we will then send in at the end of the Lenten Season.






