

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Fourth Sunday of Lent, March 19, 2023


This is the week of our Lenten Parish Mission with Fr. Charlie Smiech. Fr. Charlie

will preach at all our weekend Masses and then begin our Parish Mission on Monday morning at 10 AM. He will give the same talk at 7 PM. On Tuesday and Wednesday the pattern will be the same, except there will be an opportunity for Confessions after the Tuesday talks. On Wednesday, there will



be an Anointing of the Sick after the morning and evening services. We will also have the Anointing of the Sick on the March 25-26 weekend at the Masses. Please come and be renewed and uplifted by Fr. Charlie's inspiring talks and blessings.

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent we continue to hear from St. John's Gospel. This time the center of attention is the blind beggar whom Jesus heals from his blindness.



But first, we have the reading from 1 Samuel. Samuel is sent by God to anoint one of Jesse's sons as king. After reviewing Jesse's 7 sons and finding none of them suitable, we are reminded that humans see the appearances, but God sees what is in the heart. Then they call the youngest son David into the banquet and he is found worthy. He is anointed as king by Samuel. St. Paul writes to the Ephesians reminding them that


they were once in darkness but are now in the light. They are called to do God's will as people of light, doing pleasing and upright things, rather than evil.


In John's Gospel, Jesus tells us a parable about a blind man. The disciples ask who sinned to make him blind. Jesus answers that his blindness is not because of sin, but for another purpose. Jesus reveals that He is the light of the world and then

heals the man's blindness with spittle and mud. His neighbors question how this happened, and he explains Jesus' words and actions and that it was done on the Sabbath. The Pharisees were surprised that Jesus did this on the Sabbath and questioned his parents who told them to ask the



man himself. His explanation wasn't acceptable, so they threw him out. Jesus concludes the interaction by asking the man if he believes in the Son of Man, and he professes his faith. Jesus finally tells the Pharisees directly that they are the blind ones and their sin remains. This movement from blindness to sight is an allegory for




