# Holy Family Parish



*“Free them from the slavery of sin...”*  
(Prayer of Exorcism, First Scrutiny)

Around the world this Sunday, and on the next two Sundays, those adults who are preparing to be baptized at Easter (the “elect”) will celebrate what the Church calls the “Scrutinies.” The purpose of the Scrutinies is to reveal what is weak, sick, and sinful

in the hearts of the elect so that it can be healed; and what is honorable, strong, and holy, so that it can be strengthened. The Scrutinies are ordered toward liberation from sin and Satan, and they give strength in Christ, Who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. They are intended to purify hearts and minds and fortify against temptations.

Here at Holy Family Church, the three Scrutinies will take place at one of the Masses each weekend, a different Mass each week. At those Masses, we will hear Gospels that fill our spirits with the sense of Christ the Redeemer, Who is living water (Gospel of the Samaritan Woman at the Well), light (Gospel of the Man Born Blind), and resurrection and life (Gospel of the Raising of Lazarus).

The Scrutinies take place after the homily. They begin with a moment of silence as we pray for the elect, asking them to be given a sense of sin, a spirit of repentance, and the true freedom of the children of God. Then we pray the intercessions for the elect (just like we do at Baptisms). Next comes what we call the prayer of exorcism, again very similar to a prayer we pray at Baptisms. In this prayer we ask that God free the elect from the slavery of sin and be converted. Finally, we invite the elect to stay with us as we continue the Mass “as a sign of hope that all God’s children will eat and drink with the Lord” one day.

Just like Baptisms, the Scrutinies are an important reminder to all of us of the gift of salvation we have received in Jesus Christ. They are an opportunity for us to recommit ourselves to our Christian vocation and to renew our spirit of repentance, confident in Christ’s victory over sin and death.

Please pray for our sister Katey Stout, who will be celebrating the Scrutinies this year as she prepares to be baptized at the Easter Vigil. Please pray also for Brandi and Kayne Cornett, and Linda and David Adams, who are already baptized and will be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church at Easter.

Melanie Rita, daughter of Benjamin and Katherine Gehring, was baptized after the 5:30 Mass last weekend. Let’s all welcome our sister in Christ Melanie Rita to the household of God. Alleluia!

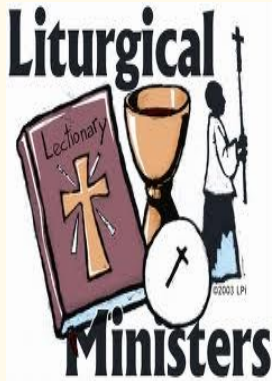
