

#### Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Second Sunday of Lent, March 5, 2023

We want to congratulate our RCIA Candidates Whitney Lambert and Meg Noble-

Rauch and their sponsors Nick Prickel and Wendy Havens. They participated in the Rite of Sending and Signing the Book of the Elect the past 2 weekends, and were welcomed by Archbishop Charles Thompson at the Cathedral in Indianapolis this past Sunday. They will complete the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults at our Easter Vigil this Spring,



along with Whitney's sister Cassie Wratten who lives out of town. Please keep them in your prayers during this last phase of their formation during this season of Lent. Remember, we, too, are on our Lenten journey as well, deepening our understanding of our Baptism through our call to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

On this Second Sunday of Lent our Scriptures continue to lead us toward a better understanding of our faith and our call to trust in the Lord. Our reading from the Book of Genesis tells of Abram's and Sarah's call to go forth from their homeland to a new



land where they will become a great nation. By their obedience and trust, they will become a source of blessing to their people and to all the nations of the earth. St. Paul writes to Timothy encouraging him to trust in God and bear the hardships of being a disciple of Christ. Christ Jesus, by His death and resurrection, will endow Timothy and all of us with the grace necessary to be His faithful followers.

St. Matthew's Gospel account of the Transfiguration of Jesus gives us, along with the disciples, a preview of Jesus' glory yet to come, after His Passion and Death when He rises from the dead in His Resurrection. On Mount Tabor, Peter, James and John, in the presence of Moses and Elijah, witness Jesus in His glory. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets. The Father proclaims "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him." This vision gives Peter, James and John the strength they will need to be faithful to Jesus even in His suffering. They and we are told "not to be afraid." As we proceed on our Lenten journey, may we too be strengthened to remain faithful disciples through trust in Jesus and not to be afraid.

Brother John Barker arrived this past Saturday and is settling in. He is eager to begin working in our parish and we are meeting with him to outline the many ways he can contribute to all of us by his ministry. He will be here with us until the end of next March as he discerns his call to priesthood.

Thanks to all who donated to our special collections for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, as well as the collection for the victims of the earthquakes in Syria and Turkey. This weekend we have a second collection for the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa. If that isn't enough, we are also collecting donations for the fresh water project for the poor people in Malawi, Ghana, and Zambia as our Lenten project!

Covenant Resources assembles

miscarriage totes for facilities (hospitals, doctor offices, funeral homes, pregnancy resource centers) that allow a woman to go into that facility and leave with the supplies she needs without waiting for them to arrive in the mail. Covenant Resources does not charge to assemble the totes and does not make any profit. However, there are \$150 worth of supplies in each tote which will help multiple families. Many facilities want the totes, but it is often daunting for them to acquire funding to purchase them. Please consider purchasing a tote (or part of a tote) that can be given to a facility near you. 



Deepen your understanding and appreciation for the Liturgy.


Fr. Jim will share thoughts on the origin of the Eucharist, and how we are called to live out our faith as we are nourished by God's love made present in the Eucharist.


