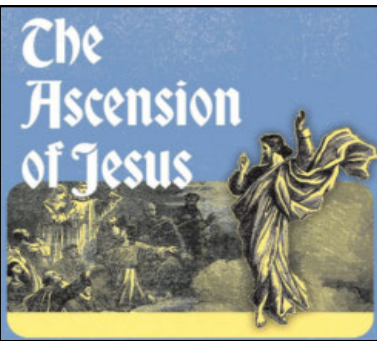

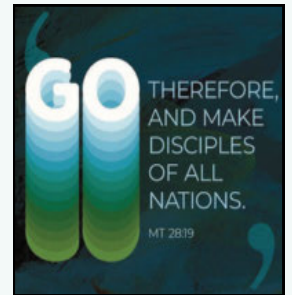

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Feast of the Ascension of the Lord, May 21, 2023

We are drawing to the close of the Easter Season with our celebration of the Ascension this weekend & Pentecost next weekend. During this time we have prayed & reflected on the events of Jesus' life, death, Resurrection & Ascension, as well as the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and disciples. We have reviewed the actions of the early disciples and apostles as they went forth from Jerusalem to preach and teach the early Christian communities scattered around the Mediterranean and mid-east areas.



Today our first reading is from the very beginning of the Acts of the Apostles.



St. Luke reviews briefly what he covered in his Gospel, ending with the 40 days of post-resurrection appearances. He promises the coming of the Holy Spirit, which will make them witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. Then Jesus was lifted up and a cloud took Him from their sight. St. Paul, writing to the Ephesians, promises them a Spirit of wisdom and revelation, that they will be enlightened, giving them hope and insight into the riches of His glory. Jesus is head

over all things for His Body the Church, and fulfills all things in every way. St. Matthew's Gospel describes the Ascension of Jesus into heaven, after He sends them forth to make disciples of all nations, Baptizing them in the name of the Trinity, teaching them to observe all that they have been commanded. Then Jesus promises to be with them (and us) until the end of the age. We Christians have received this promise and this commission, to extend the Church to all nations of the world. This is what we commit ourselves to every time someone is Baptized.

Thanks to all our Catechists, Teachers, Staff and Parents who have worked hard these past 9 months to instruct all of our children in our Religious Education Program. Beth Geis has served well in organizing and guiding all of our educators. We celebrated



with the May Crowning Mass last Wednesday, followed by our ice cream social. Thanks to the Schrank family for providing the home-made ice cream. We also thank the Knights of St. John and Columbus for their service at our May Crowning and this past Sunday for preparing our delicious Mother's Day Breakfast.
